### MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- i. Assist the Project Manager in reviewing documents but not limited to the Environmental impact Assessment (EIA), Process simulations, process flow diagrams (PFDs), Process data sheets, and piping and instrument diagrams (P & IDs) forwarded from the Pipeline Company for CPC information and review.
- ii. Assist the Project Manager in the approval process of the relevant documents to be approved as per the Agreement and the Request for Proposal (RFP) documents between CPC and the Pipeline Company.
- iii. Assess the Global LNG market trends and analyze the future trends. Report to the Manager on LNG trends and Global Market conditions.
- iv. Coordinate with CPC Technical Specifications Committee on LNG related technical matters and obtain the approval of CPC Technical Specifications Committee for LNG import specifications. Represent the CPC Technical Specifications Committee as an Invitee on behalf of the LNG Function in the absence of LNG Manager.
- v. Maintain the statistics of the country with regard to the LNG demand and supply and analyze the future trends to assist LNG procurements.
- vi. Represent CPC as the process Engineer during the operation of the LNG pipeline by the LNG pipeline Company and liaise with the Pipeline Company to acquire knowledge on Pipeline operations.
- vii. Any other duties entrusted by the Manager (LNG) when and where necessary.
