(Other allowances determined by the University Grants Commission will be paid in addition to the above salary. In addition Academic Allowance for the post A&B, 151% and for the post C, 131% and post D, 115% of the salary and a Research Allowance of 35% of the salary to the posts only A to D will be paid.)

Benefits:

- Selected candidates will contribute 10% of their monthly salary to the Universities' Provident Fund, while the University will make a contribution of 15% of their salary of which 8% will be credited to the Universities Pension Fund and 7% to the Universities' Provident Fund. In addition, they will become contributors to the Employees' Trust Fund to which the University will contribute an amount equivalent to 3% of the salary.
- Gratuity payment will be in accordance with the provisions of the Payment of Gratuity Act 12 of 1983.
- The holders of the posts of Senior Lecturer Grade II and above are eligible for one-year sabbatical leave with full pay or two years of leave without pay on completion of seven years of service. Further, those proceeding abroad on sabbatical leave period are eligible to receive full insurance for self and spouse.
