## GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (ADVANCED LEVEL) EXAMINATION – 2021

Applications for this examination should be submitted only through online method.

Instructions to complete and submit the application are published in the official website of the Department of Examinations (<https://doenets.lk>) or in the online examination website (<https://onlineexams.gov.lk/cic>) or in the official mobile app (“DoE” mobile app).

Applications of private candidates for this examination will be accepted from 05<sup>th</sup> July 2021 to 12.00 midnight of 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Each private candidate is advised to read this notification fully and thoroughly understand before filling and submitting the application online. Special attention should be paid in accurately entering the selected **Town and Subjects** of the examination. Candidates are allowed only to apply for maximum of 03 main subjects. In addition, the applicants can apply for Subject No.12 - Common General Test and Subject No. 13 - General English as applicable.

**Applying for the examinations should be conducted in two main stages in this year.**

Stage I - Entering information and receiving the Reference Number.

Enter your personal information, examination information, subject details and payment method. You should obtain the reference number to make payment through post office.

Stage II - Payment of examination fee and downloading the application.

Upon submitting the reference number to the post office you may pay the examination fee to the post office and then visit the website by login in or by activating the link you have been sent via SMS and then download the application by clicking “Download AL 2021 Application” of the website.

Candidates who paid examination fee through bank cards also can download application by above

**Candidates who have not appeared even for a part of a paper will only be considered as candidates not appeared for the examination. Since the examination attempt to enroll in a university for such candidates will not be cancelled, they are not required to provide any medical certificates. Keeping the admission card of the candidate safely in possession is the only evidence to prove not appearing for any subject of the examination. It is not required to submit medical certificates or any other requests to this department in that regard.**
