This has reference to the confidential Msg. No.82 dated 7th October 2022 received from the Sri Lankan High Commission (SLHC) in Singapore regarding proposed visit of the officials of Ministry of Health Holdings (MOHH) to Sri Lanka from 19th to 26th November 2022 (A copy is enclosed herewith-Annex -1).

- 2) As a result of the discussions had by the SLHC in Singapore with the Ministry of Health (MOH) of Singapore regarding a Pilot project for recruitment of qualified Nurses and Healthcare Assistants to Singapore, the MOH has conveyed their interest in visiting Sri Lanka along with the officials of MOHH, which is the recruiting arm of MOH, from 19th to 26th of November 2022, with the below-mentioned two main objectives.
 - a) To conduct a technical evaluation to understand and evaluate the standards and the academic background of the Sri Lankan healthcare Sector.

The officials of MOHH wish to meet senior officials of;

- The Sri Lanka Nursing Council (SLNC)
- Private Health Services Regulatory Authority (PHSRA)
- Government Nurses Training School of Sri Lanka
- A state and a private university that offer BSc (Nursing) degrees

- Government Nurses Training School
- Department of Nursing
- A private university that offers BSc (Nursing) degree

- 1. This has reference to FAX No. 78 (Dated 26/09/2022) & 79 (Dated 30/09/2022) forwarded to SLBFE by this Mission concerning the subject mentioned above.
- 2. In addition to the recently circulated FAXES, this Mission would like to draw the attention of the SLBFE to the initial discussion conducted by this Mission with the Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Health and Ministry of Manpower, Dr. Koh Poh Koon on the 14th October 2021. The meeting brief and the meeting minutes were forwarded to the former State Minister of Foreign Employment & Market Diversification are attached herewith for your perusal (Annex-1 & 1.1).
- 3. Ministry of Health Holdings Limited (MOHH), which is the recruitment arm of the Ministry of Health of Singapore, was introduced to the High Commission of Sri Lanka in Singapore by the Senior Minister of State, Dr. Koh Poh Koon as a result of the discussions held to secure healthcare sector employment opportunities for Sri Lankans.

- 4. The labor section of this Mission has been maintaining a close relationship with MOHH in developing a recruitment program since then. During the peak of the pandemic, MOHH conveyed their interest in recruiting a batch of Sri Lankan healthcare sector workers on an urgent basis through a remote recruitment process.
- 5. This Mission has been continuously developing discussions with the Ministry of Health and MOHH of Singapore in recognizing Sri Lanka as a traditional healthcare sector recruitment source. MOHH is a state-owned subsidiary of the Singapore Ministry of Health responsible for recruiting healthcare sector workers for Singapore government hospitals and the technical evaluation of foreign recruitment sources.
- 6. As a successful result of the extended discussions this Mission had with MOHH, they have conveyed their interest in making a trip to Sri Lanka from 19th-26th of November (Annex- 2). The proposed visit will have two main objectives: to conduct a technical evaluation of the Sri Lankan healthcare Sector to recognize Sri Lanka as a traditional health sector recruitment source and a pilot face-to-face recruitment project due to the urgent healthcare sector manpower shortage in Singapore.
 - A. Technical Evaluation of the Sri Lankan Healthcare Sector- The MOHH has requested assistance from the High Commission of Sri Lanka in Singapore in arranging meetings and visits to the following institutions and regulatory authorities:

Meetings with:

- 1. Sri Lanka Nursing Council dignitaries (SLNC)
- 2. Private Health Services Regulatory Authority dignitaries (PHSRA)
- 3. Academic staff of Government Nurses Training School of Sri Lanka, a BSc in Nursing Awarding State University, and a Private University

Visits to:

- 1. Sri Jayawardenapura University Nursing School
- 2. Government Nurses Training School
- 3. Sri Lanka Open University Nursing School
- 4. A Private BSc in Nursing awarding University
- 5. Sri Jayawardenapura state hospital
- 6. A Private Hospital

The motive of these meetings and visits will be to understand and evaluate the standards and academic background of the Sri Lankan healthcare sector. Based on the technical evaluation of the Sri Lankan healthcare sector, the process of getting into a G2G framework agreement which has already been proposed to the Singapore Ministry of Manpower and Ministry of Foreign Affairs by the High Commission of Sri Lanka in Singapore can be expedited.

B. Pilot Recruitment Project- MOHH has appointed Vision Manpower Limited (VML) Singapore as their project facilitator (Annex-3) respectively VML has appointed Emerald Isle Manpower & Travel Services (EMP) as their Sri Lankan project facilitator (Annex-4). Consequently, MOHH and VML have requested the assistance of the High Commission of Sri Lanka in Singapore and other related Sri Lankan counterparts to make this pilot

recruitment project successful in sourcing qualified Sri Lanka Nursing Council registered candidates (Recruitment Criteria- Annex- 5).

7. In the above context, the Singapore healthcare sector delegation would consist of officials from three principal institutions; the Ministry of Health Holdings, Singapore Nursing Board (SNB), and Ministry of Health. However, due to the tight schedule of the dignitaries of the above institutions, MOHH has proposed that the visit will commence with the pilot recruitment project where the Deputy Director of MOHH and Manager of MOHH will accompany the interviewers and the exam invigilators on the 19th and conduct the interview process from the 20th to the 22nd of November. The SNB examination is scheduled to be conducted in all recruitment source countries (Philipines, Indonesia, Vietnam, etc.) on 23rd November at 12 PM Singapore time (9.30 AM Sri Lanka time). Following the first batch of the delegation, the Chairperson of SNB, Group Chief Nurse of Singapore, Director of MOHH. Assistant Secretary of SNB, and an Official from the Ministry of Health of Singapore will join the delegation from the 22nd November onwards to commence the technical evaluation and the study trip (Tentative program agenda is as follows).
