- Minimum of three (03) passes in G.C.E A/L examination in one sitting (new syllabus)/ minimum of four (04) passes in one sitting (old syllabus) in Commerce Stream; OR
- Passed Level 2 Examination of Association of Accounting Technicians (AAT) of Sri Lanka/Executive Level of Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka (ICASL)/ Foundation Level of Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA-UK) or Foundation Level of Institute of Certified Management Accountants of Sri Lanka (CMA)/ Knowledge Module of Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA-UK); OR
- Minimum of three (03) passes in G.C.E A/L examination in one sitting (new syllabus)/ minimum of four (04) passes in one sitting (old syllabus) in any other stream and one (01) year post-qualifying working experience in the Accounting /Business field; OR
- d Any Advanced Certificate (equivalent to SLQF Level 2 or NVQF Level 4) or any other equivalent qualification approved by the Qualification Evaluation Committee; AND
