Job Description

Carryout maintenance work on aircraft, engines, their associated components, as directed by the supervising authorization holder / maintenance executive in order to maintain the airworthiness of the aircrafts in an efficient manner and achieving high productivity levels, to meet the Company Quality Standards, Airworthiness authority requirements and provide aircraft maintenance services to other operators to meet their complete satisfaction.

Job accountabilities:

- Perform aircraft maintenance activities including component replacements, servicing and assist in defect rectification under the supervision of the engineer / approval holder in charge of the aircraft in an efficient and productive manner using approved data, material, tooling in order to maintain the airline schedule.
- Perform marshaling, arrival and departure procedure, assist during towing/aircraft movement /docking etc. as instructed by the aircraft maintenance executive or the authorization holder.
- Communicate effectively with the supervising staff in regard to the progress of tasks assigned.
- Maintain the toolbox and the tool inventory according to regulatory requirements. Care is taken during handling common tools, equipment and associated spares to prevent damage. Ensure that the tools are returned in a serviceable condition, or any damages are informed prior to return to stores.
- To ensure maintenance of good housekeeping standards in work area and within Airplane confines so that Airplane safety is not compromised, and a pleasing and contributory work environment is recognized.
- Ensure all removed components are stored and aircraft spares/consumables are returned as per laid down procedure to prevent damage/wastage and audit findings.
- Ensure holding of a valid driving permit and safe manuring of aircraft maintenance steps and equipment in the vicinity of the aircraft, and also maintaining discipline while driving in the base/ apron and within the company premises.
- To ensure all mandatory training is kept current by informing the aircraft maintenance executive of the refresher training requirement at least 3 months prior to the validity expiry date.
- Remain safety conscious and exercise care when performing duties by conforming with safety procedures, regulations and standards including reporting of hazards and prevention of accidents, incidents, maintenance errors on a regular basis in order to ensure a safe operating working environment.

Requirements

6 passes at GCE O/L with 4 Credit passes or equivalent, including credits for English, Mathematics and Science obtained in one sitting. The credit for English may be obtained in any sitting.

AND

A CAASL IS 147 approved full-time basic aircraft maintenance course in category B1.1 or B2, conducted by a CAASL IS 147 approved Maintenance Training Organization

OR

A full-time basic aircraft maintenance course conducted by an Aeronautical Military school, with the course duration not less than one year. Such course is accepted only after review of the course outline by SriLankan Quality Assurance.

OR

A full-time basic aircraft maintenance course approved by the competent authority of an ICAO member state and conducted by an organization approved by such authority, in categories B1.1 or B2. If the categories defined by the member state are different, such courses may be accepted only after review of the course outline by SriLankan Quality Assurance. In any case, the minimum course duration shall be Two years.

The upper age limit should be 50 years as at the closing date 18th November 2023.

Employment will be offered on fixed term contract.
