



Identification of Skill Assessment Centers for selected job categories in Construction/ Manufacturing/Hospitality/Logistic sectors

The Sri Lanka Bureau of Foreign Employment was established by Act No. 21 of 1985, and one of its main objectives is to direct skilled Sri Lankan workers to overseas employment markets.

In the process of recruiting skilled workers for foreign employment, there is a need to identify skill assessment centers that can test the skill levels of the relevant applicants.

Those skill assessment tests must be conducted under a very high standard, and applications are invited from vocational training/ industries institutions that are registered /accredited or wish to be registered /accredited under the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission (TVEC), and capable of conducting relevant assessment tests.

The institutions should be capable of conducting skill assessment tests in relation to the below-mentioned employment sectors and job categories and such other categories of employment.
